Specific functions the candidate will have to carry out, teaching and scientific commitments:	<p>Teaching Activities: The candidate will be expected to carry out teaching activities within the framework of the Academic sector 11/E1 Disciplinary Scientific Area of SSD M-PSI/03 PSYCHOMETRICS and must have adequate teaching and research experience in this area. The required teaching commitment consists in carrying out teaching of SSD M-PSI/03 PSYCHOMETRICS within the Department of Humanities, Social Sciences and Education (SUSEF) and the Department of Medicine, subordinately, in other departments of the University. In addition, the required figure should possess a strong aptitude for teaching in the SSD with special emphasis on basic psychometrics, test theory and techniques, psychometric assessment of adults and aging, and advanced teaching on topics pertaining to the SSD delivered at doctoral or undergraduate specialization courses. The teaching commitment also includes tutoring, assisting students in writing papers for the final examination of three-year courses, master's theses, and doctoral dissertations. Special attention should be paid to incoming and ongoing orientation activities, internationalization and third mission.</p> <p>Research Activities: The candidate should possess the ability to carry out research activities within the Disciplinary Scientific Sector SSD M-PSI/03 PSYCHOMETRICS. In particular, the required figure must possess a marked aptitude for research proven by his or her scientific production in international journals, including high-impact ones, on topics included in the declaratory of the SSD with particular regard to measurement techniques - test construction and validation - as well as to the development and in-depth study of statistical techniques capable of improving the process of assessment and evaluation of psychological constructs a) objectively assessed such as: (1) decline of cognitive processes with aging, (2) memory and spatial mental representation in adults and the elderly or (b) self-reported such as (1) active aging, functional autonomy, quality of life in aging; (2) mindwandering and mindfulness.</p>
Nationally recognized quality standards and any additional elements of scientific qualification:	The candidate will be expected to demonstrate continuity in research, also with a view to figure significant results in the upcoming VQR evaluations of the Department of Humanities Social Sciences and Education. Considerable internationalization of research products alongside those more specifically focused on the national context is required, as well as proven experience in participation and/or coordination of national and international

	competitive public calls and/or in collaboration with private entities and involvement/coordination of institutional, research and third mission activities of the Department and the University.
